

Upon the Claimant's application dated 21 August 2017 and 5 September 2017

And Upon hearing the Claimant in person, the Defendant not being present or represented

It is ordered as follows:

IF YOU FAIL TO COMPLY WITH THIS ORDER YOU MAY BE HELD IN CONTEMPT OF COURT AND BE SENTENCED TO IMPRISONMENT OR HAVE YOUR ASSETS SEIZED

- 1. The Defendant is restrained from doing the following acts or any of them, whether by doing them himself or by causing, permitting or encouraging any other person to do them on his behalf:
- (a) harrassing the Claimant in any way and/or interfering with his quiet enjoyment of boats, mooring, parking places and outbuildings located at St Neots PE19
- (b) without prejudice to the generality of (a) above:
- i. obstructing the Claimant pedestrian or vehicular access to the above property;
- ii. damaging the said outbuilding and/or obstructing the Claimant's access to them;
- iii. doing any act likely to frighten or intimidate the Claimant.
- 2. Not later than 12 noon on Monday 18 September 2017 the Defendant is required to remove any locks or other obstructions, including vehicles, interfering with the Claimant's quiet enjoyment of the above property.
- 3. The Defendant is forbidden from taking any steps to remove the Claimant or any of his property from except as permitted by an Order of the Court.
- 4. The hearing on this case listed for 21 September 2017 is vacated.

5. The Defendant may apply to the Court at any time, on 2 clear days' notice to the Claimant, to vary or set aside this Order. Such an application may be made to any District Judge or Circuit Judge at Peterborough or Cambridge.
